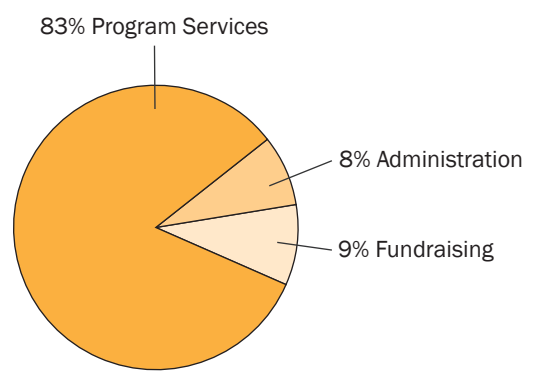

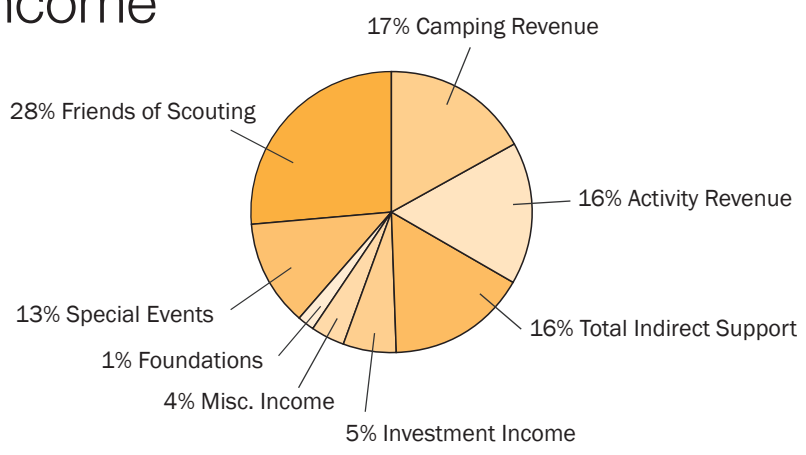

Scout Oath

On my honor I will do my best to do my duty to God and my country and to obey the Scout law; to help other people at all times; to keep myself physically strong, mentally awake, and morally straight.

Scout Law

Loyal	Cheerful
Helpful	Thrifty
Friendly	Brave
Courteous	Clean
Kind	Reverent

For 100 years, Scouting has been helping the youth of America find more than they thought possible.

A century of building confidence and character is worth celebrating! The following timeline captures some of Scouting's major milestones through our history:

- 1910** The Boy Scouts of America is incorporated on February 8 under the laws of District of Columbia by W.D. Boyce.
- 1915** Troop 1 in Los Gatos, CA was first chartered by the National Council.
- 1920** The Santa Clara County Council was organized, serving 198 Scouts.
- 1940s** The Santa Clara County Council purchased 100 acres of land from Edward Jenness in the sum of \$10. It was named Camp Hi-Sierra.
- 1950s** Scout Circuses and Scout-O-Rama were held in alternate years at the San Jose State University Spartan Stadium.
- 1970s** The Santa Clara County Council received a gift of 413 acres of undeveloped forest land from Nessie and Paul Chesebrough.
- 1980s** Many Scout troops and Explorer posts participated in emergency service activities following the October 17, 1989 earthquake.
- 2000s** The Boy Scout of America's 100 millionth youth is registered.
- 2010** During the Council's 90 anniversary, we plan to serve over 20,000 youth - doubling the number served in 2005 - while the Boy Scouts of America celebrates 100 years of Scouting in America.
